They range from the tropics to the arctic and are widespread in Canada, the United States, Mexico, and Central America. Stress-tolerant species occur where salinity or depth and duration of inundation are greater and hypoxia more pronounced such as the lower elevations of salt marshes, but studies have demonstrated that these species are often poor competitors in fresher or higher-elevation sites, such as the higher elevations of tidal freshwater wetlands.
