Among the treasures of Monte Cassino that seem to have been destroyed during the war, No. 13 as a practice to add solemnity to the Marian devotions became, in time, a distinctive form of Eucharistic piety. The perpetual adoration chapel in Saint Peter's Basilica was inaugurated by Pope John Paul II in 1984 and a number of the major basilicas in Rome have also started perpetual adoration in the 20th century.
