The piano then descends as in the first phrase, this time to a full cadence in E major. Universal Edition No.

The piano continues to play it six-against-four rhythm. Finally, all three strings join together as they approach a climax. The theme itself, led by the piano, is bright and broad.

It seems to point to F minor, but this is never confirmed. The first beat is a more powerful, widely spaced chord that includes the full strings.
