Work with frames and objects in InDesign

Adobe InDesign objects include any item you can add If a graphic exists inside a frame (as all imported).

Whenever you place a graphic into your document, InDesign creates a link to the original file. You can see the link circled in red in the snapshot below.

Adding Images/Graphics. To add an image to an InDesign document, you must Place it, just like we placed text. Make sure the Selection Tool is.
